The two companies are fully committed to bridging the gap in the eVTOL industry, where a strong mutual understanding between manufacturers and insurers is absolutely crucial.

This pioneering partnership will aspire not only to set a benchmark for industry standards, but also to help promote a more proactive approach to eVTOL insurability.
